I would like to say a huge thank you to all of you for your support during this period of partial school closure. We all acknowledge what a challenging time it is for families and I hope that you now get to enjoy a relaxing half term.

### Remote education survey

I would also like to thank those of you who completed our remote education survey. It was extremely beneficial for us to gain further insight into how you are feeling about the home learning tasks that are being set. Teachers have been provided with a copy of your individual responses so that they can address any matters arising from your survey responses.

As a result of this, and the helpful comments and suggestions we have received, we have decided to have two assemblies per week moving forwards. I would also like to thank you for all the lovely messages you gave to the staff who have been working so hard to support both those children in school and those at home. The classroom based staff are having to juggle two different roles at this time and your kind words have been very much appreciated by all.

Each family has differing demands at this present time due to work commitments and access to technology, we will therefore continue to offer pre-recorded sessions rather than live lessons to support families to vary the timetable to one that works for their own personal circumstances.

The Friends of Heritage Park Primary School have provided us with funding to purchase 21 additional Chromebooks and Microsoft licences. We are very grateful to one of our parents, who have helped us to secure funding of £1500 from BGL, to go towards technology for the children.

### Returning to school

At this time we have not been provided with any updates as to when schools are likely to fully re-open. The staff all continue to be in school on a fulltime basis and are here to help if you need anything. We are expecting a government announcement in the first week back after half term. To date, schools have been informed of changes to education at the same time as the general public but we will keep you updated once we have more information.
