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Dear Year 6 Parents

Please find below a summary of the areas the children will be learning about this term.

We will be learning about...	
English	This term, we will focus on the accuracy of our grammar, punctuation and spelling, within a range of extended pieces of writing. We will use our editing skills to revise and improve our work, thinking carefully about our purpose and audience.
Maths	This term, we will be learning about line graphs and pie charts. We will be measuring and calculating angles and looking at nets of a range of 3D shapes.
Science	The topic this half term is 'Living things and their habitats'. The children will describe how living things are classified into groups based on their characteristics, including micro-organisms, plants and animals. Next half term, we will focus on electricity and investigate circuits and circuit components, and the related symbols.
Computing	We will spend time considering how to stay safe online and will also design and create a webpage.
PE	During the first half term we will be developing our physical skills using frisbees. During the second half of the term, we will be participating in team games and developing our athletics skills.
Guided Reading	We will be looking at a range of extracts from previous SATs to support the children to develop their comprehension skills.
Art	The artist we will be studying this term is a local artist called Kathryn Parsons. She specialises in botanical ceramics. The children will spend time carrying out observational drawing of plants and creating botanical inspired Fimo sculptures.
Design and Technology	Year 6 will be developing their knowledge of stitching techniques, decorative sewing skills and fastenings to design, make and evaluate their own cushion cover.
Religious Education	This term we will be looking at Humanism and exploring what is involved in humanism in terms of their beliefs and ideologies.
History	We will spend time this term learning about the topic 'Posh Old Peterborough'. Within our work we will learn about the history of our local area including: Peterborough during World War 2, Peterborough Abbey and Hereward the Wake, Flag Fen,



	Transport, and the Tudor and Stuart Queens linked to Peterborough.
Geography	We will explore Sheffield and its surrounding area as a contrasting locality to Peterborough. This will be done through looking at maps, statistics and photographs in addition to other sources of information.
PSHE	This term we will be focusing on safety and risk taking. We will consider potential dangers that children may face and consider how to seek support and deal with issues including: road safety, first aid, and dangers in the home and in their environment. We will also look at healthy lifestyles and how we can take responsibility for our health through a good diet and exercise regime.
Music	The children will continue to work with Mrs Woolf in music. They will explore body percussion and create a whole class composition with it. They will also begin to learn to write music using conventional notation.
French	We will continue to learn about vocabulary linked with 'The Home' and then move on to learning about 'Travel' and the related vocabulary and phrases.
